## **Description:**

The Pinellas County African American History Museum is located in the former Curtis Elementary School and is one of only two remaining structures that were originally all-black public schools in upper Pinellas County, Florida. Being located in a former school afforded the museum the opportunity to use the existing library for cataloguing and displaying its book collection.

The collection includes books of various genres: children's books, poetry, autobiography and biography, pamphlets and essays, cook books, novels, drama, social science, history, etc. The collection is also comprised of books on local history.
